Sunlight Requirements



Full Sun is 6 or more hours of direct sun a day

Full sun plants like bright sunny areas. Many full sun plants will be perfectly happy with sun 14 hours a day, every day. Some plants are happy with sun 14 hours a day, unless it gets hot then they like some afternoon shade (when the sun is hottest.) How do you know which sun plants prefer a bit of a heat break? If the plant is noted as being great for early spring it is a good bet that it will be happiest with some afternoon shade. Some plants that fall into this category are Pansies, Violas, Diascia, Nemesis, Osteospermum, and Argyranthemum. Plants that are noted as heat and/or drought tolerant are generally pretty tolerant of even hot afternoon sun. Plants in this category include Rudbeckia (black eyed susan), Echinacea (purple coneflower), Heliopsis, Coreopsis, Angelonia (Snapdragon), Phlox, Scaevola, Chrysocephalum etc...

Partial Sun or Partial Shade is 4 to 6 hours of direct sun a day

Partial sun and partial shade are probably the most confusing category. The two terms are fairly interchangeable. These plants prefer 4 to 6 hours of sun a day and would be happiest getting their sun mostly in the morning and/or evening with shade through the middle of the day. If a plant is called partial sun the emphasis is on making sure the plant gets at least 4 hours of sun a day. If a plant is called partial shade then greater emphasis is placed on the plant not getting more than 6 hours of direct sun.

You may also see the term Dappled Shade. Dappled shade refers to areas where there is a mixture of sun and shade, generally because a deciduous tree is nearby. Dappled shade is similar to partial shade. Plants in this category are often woodland plants and will do best with little full sun (even morning or evening sun). These plants thrive on full days of sun that has been filtered by trees. Bloodroot, Aquilegia (Columbine), Wild Ginger, Wild Violets, Jack-in-the-Pulpit, and Meadow Rue are examples of woodland plants.

Full Shade is less than 4 hours of direct sun a day

Full shade plants prefer to get little direct sun. They like less than 4 hours of direct sun a day and prefer morning and evening sun to mid-day sun. Full shade plants should also do outstanding in dappled shade conditions. An area that will be shaded by a fence or wall will need to get several hours of sun in either morning or evening for plants to do well. Full shade does not refer to dark places. All plants need at least some light.

Grasses

Full sun

- Dwarf Fountain 3' X 2'
Attractive grass highlighted by fluffy, buff-colored plumes arching above foliage. Terrific contrast used among shrub or backdrop for perennial bed. Foliage turns golden russet in fall. Perennial.
- Blue Oat 3' X 3'
Graceful fountains of silver-blue blades form neat ornamental clumps that combine well with other grasses. Beige to light brown terminal panicles appear June through August. Reliable and attractive accent or specimen, perfect for rock gardens. Evergreen perennial.
- Maiden 6' X 3'
Attractive clumping ornamental grass with fine-textured silver-green blades that turn golden bronze after first frost. Great specimen for shrub or perennial beds, or when used in groups as a screen.

Part sun - full sun

- Fox Red Curly Sedge 2' X 3'
Striking clumps of red-bronze foliage fades to flax at the tips, giving off a warm glow when back-lit by the sun. This versatile Sedge thrives in wet areas around ponds and water gardens, yet is tolerant of dry conditions
- Morning Light 5' X 2'
Green blades have highlights of creamy-white margins and mid-veins creating a shimmering silvery appearance. Adds visual excitement wherever used. Accepts dry conditions. Deciduous.
- Purple Silver 4' X 4'
Slightly gray-green blades in summer turn brilliant red-orange in fall. Attractive coloring lasting through the winter. Mauve-colored feathery plumes rise above the foliage. A focal point for borders and containers. Herbaceous
- Variegated Japanese 6' X 3'
Gracefully arching grass topped with silvery white plumes. Dark green blades are highlighted with creamy white stripes. Include for textural contrast in perennial or shrub beds.
- Miniature Cattail 18" X 18"
Deciduous perennial with grass-like, very narrow stiff green leaves. Rising above the foliage are decorative, miniature, cylindrical seed heads. Very effective for moist sites around ponds and water.

Part sun

All Gold Japanese Forest

18" X 18"

A graceful, colorful groundcover for shady areas. Slender stems hold bright golden-yellow foliage having the effect of a tiny bamboo. Great in containers or color accent in borders.

Shrubs

Full sun

- Barberry - Golden Nugget 12" X 18"
An exceptional golden Barberry in an exciting, compact, dwarf form. Displays attractive, non-burning foliage with a golden-orange cast most of the season. Excellent color
- Barberry - Concorde 18" X 18"
A diminutive purple-leaf Barberry with deep maroon purple foliage that becomes even more intense during fall. Small yellow flowers followed by bright red berries. Perfect size for edging as a small hedge or for containers.
- Spirea - Magic Carpet 18" X 24"
A neat, compact mound with vibrant new red leaves. Clusters of small pink flowers contrasting with the bright gold mature foliage. Rich russet fall foliage color. This extraordinary combination of colors will brighten and enhance any landscape.
- Barberry - Golden Ruby 2' X 2'
A beautiful, slow growing, compact shrub with striking coral-orange foliage. Late season foliage is accented with a golden margin. Excellent low-maintenance landscape plant for mass plantings or an eye-catching color contrast. This vigorous selection has exhibited outstanding cold hardiness, possibly to USDA Zone 3 with winter protection.
- Butterfly Bush - Lo & Behold 2' X 2'
This new addition to the Lo & Behold® series is more compact than 'Blue Chip', with a dwarf, slightly spreading habit. Soft, lavender-pink fragrant flowers provide color from summer until frost, without deadheading! Fragrant bloom spikes attract butterflies. Perfect for mass planting, perennial gardens and mixed borders. This deer resistant shrub is sterile and will not produce seedlings
- Carpet Rose 2' x 3'
An incredibly prolific bloomer, this groundcover rose is a vivid spot of color from spring until winter. Low, dense foliage on mounding form with velvety, carmine red 2 inch wide flowers with bright yellow centers. Foliage is highly disease resistant, tinged red at first, then fading with age to dark green with burgundy edges. Tolerant of drought once established.
- Barberry - Crimson Pygmy 2' X 3'
A dwarf, densely branched form displaying deep crimson colored foliage all season long. Best in full sun. Excellent for borders or small hedges.
- Knockout Rose 3' X 3'
A maintenance free rose that continually produces self-cleaning double candy apple red and pink flowers with a slight spicy fragrance. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot and downy mildew leaf diseases. An excellent low hedge or accent

- Weigela - Dark Horse 3' X 3'
 Dark bronze foliage with lime-green venation combines with purplish-pink tubular flowers to make a dramatic statement in the landscape. Neat, compact habit is easy to maintain. Perfect for accent or shrub border.
- Potentilla Red Ace 3' X 4'
 Showy deciduous shrub with flowers of rich vermilion with undersides of pale yellow. Flowers change from red to yellow under intense heat. Densely branched form useful as colorful accent or border.
- Hibiscus - Dave Fleming 3' X 4'
 Very large, hot ruby red flowers with contrasting yellow stamens will add tropical flair to the garden - an instant summer garden makeover! Rare maroon-tinted foliage provides an attractive backdrop to the showy blossoms. A perfect addition to the shrub or perennial border.
- Hibiscus - Strawberry Swirl 3' X 4'
 Very large flowers bear alternating pink and pale pink petals, providing tropical appeal over a long season. Maple-like foliage is shiny green. Quick addition to the shrub or perennial border for instant makeover. Herbaceous
- Spirea - Little Princess 3' X 6'
 Dainty clusters of rose-pink blooms create a pleasing contrast with mint green foliage. Forms a neat compact rounded form that fits nicely in shrub borders
- Butterfly Bush - Miss Molly 4' X 3'
 If you think Miss Ruby has awesome flower color, Miss Molly pushes the color spectrum with blooms boasting rich hues of dark Sangria-red. Flowers appear from July until frost, a real treat for butterflies and hummingbirds! Compact branching form remains neat and tidy in the landscape, and sterile flowers will not produce unwanted seedlings.
- Burning Bush 6' X 8'
 Sensational accent or hedge desired for the intense scarlet red fall coloring. Interesting compact, mounded form displays attractive rich green leaves spring through summer. Deciduous.
- Rose of Sharon 10' X 6'
 The first ever seedless Rose of Sharon with large, rich blue flowers. This easy to grow plant adds unique color to the summer landscape. Makes an easy to maintain, colorful hedge or added to perennial borders and mixed beds.
- Magnolia - Randy 10' X 12'
 Beautiful deciduous shrub displaying star-shaped blooms later and longer than other Star Magnolias. Lovely open-branched habit. Beautiful accent or unique single specimen.

Hypericum St. Johns Wort -Gemo

2' X 2'

This Danish cultivar is popular for its prolonged bloom period and refined foliage. Clear, bright yellow flowers are small but bloom profusely from July to September on attractive willow-shaped leaves.

Weigela - My Monet

2' X 2'

This dwarf masterpiece is a sport of Weigela florida 'Tango'. As the first dwarf variegated Weigela to be introduced, its tight habit and colorful foliage make it very versatile. Variegation changes depending on light exposure - whiter variegation in shade and pink variegation in full sun. Possible applications include an artistic drift along the edge of an annual or perennial bed or as an accent piece in a container. My Monet™ creates poetic beauty in any landscape and adds a splash of color to semi shady areas.

Buxus - North Star

2' X 2'

This new variety of boxwood is a cold hardy, dense globe that requires little if any pruning to form a low, dense, thick hedge. Shiny dark green leaves maintain good winter color. Use North Star™ as a low-growing hedge, or even to create the borders of a formal herb garden. It's a beautiful evergreen that will provide four seasons of enjoyment in the landscape.

Buxus - Green Velvet

3' X 3'

A full bodied Boxwood well suited for dense, low hedges. Foliage retains its rich green color throughout winter. Vigorous, rounded form if left unshaped. Evergreen.

Hydrangea - Invincibelle Spirit

3' X 3'

Invincibelle Spirit® is the first-ever pink Annabelle hydrangea, producing loads of mophead flowers from early summer to frost. Dark pink buds open to hot pink flowers, fading to soft pink and finally to green. This hardy adaptable native selection is a reliable bloomer, even after the harshest of winters, and is also quite heat tolerant. Deciduous.

Hydrangea - Cityline Rio Bigleaf

3' X 3'

This compact early-blooming Hydrangea has one of the best blue-colored flowers and attractive glossy foliage. It has a striking green eye when opening, is long-blooming, and extremely mildew resistant. Adds drama to mixed containers, borders, or cut flower arrangements.

Hydrangea - Lets Dance Big Easy

3' X 3'

Exceptionally large, vividly colored mop-head flowers, the largest of perhaps any mop-head Hydrangea! The huge blooms go through a wonderful progression of color changes, from pinkish-green to pink, and often back to green. Soil pH affects blossom color. This reliable reblooming Hydrangea blooms every year, on both old and new wood. Great cut flower

- Hydrangea - Tuff Stuff 3' X 3'
 This fantastic new hardy, reblooming Hydrangea will provide months of enjoyment in the garden! Lovely reddish-pink lacecap flowers create a mass of color in early summer, and continue to bloom right up until frost. The semi-double to double florets begin with creamy coloration in the center before maturing to intense pink. Flowers may shift to blue in acidic soils. Deciduous.
- Hydrangea - Little Quick Fire 4' X 3'
 This is a wonderful dwarf form of the popular Quick Fire™ hydrangea. Like the original, It is early blooming, flowering about a month before other hydrangeas. White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses. Compact size fits easily into any landscape. Use it in a mixed border, or as a showy specimen or foundation plant. Its early bloom time will extend your garden's hydrangea season.
- Buxus - Winter Gem 4' X 6'
 Excellent evergreen shrub for small hedges. Among the hardiest of Boxwoods, the rich green foliage acquires a golden bronze hue through winter, returning to green in spring. Evergreen.
- Hydrangea - Limelight 6' X 8'
 An exciting hardy Hydrangea from Holland, Limelight has unique chartreuse blooms in mid-summer that change to pink in fall. Good massed, as a hedge, in containers or as a cut flower.
- Hydrangea - Quickfire 6' X 8'
 Quick Fire blooms about a month before other Hardy Hydrangea varieties and flowers every year! Flowers open white then turn pink as summer progresses. This very hardy flowering shrub is perfect in mixed containers, mass plantings, as a hedge, or cut flower.
- Dogwood - Ivory Halo 4' X 4'
 The same light green and white foliage and brilliant red winter stems of the regular form, but only two-thirds the size. Plant in shrub borders, in mass or as a low hedge. Deciduous
- Barberry - Rocket 4.5' X 1.5'
 Vibrant coral-orange new foliage ages to mid-green, then turns ruby red in autumn. This award winning, compact, upright growing shrub has a vigorous growth habit and improved resistance to rust. Use to brighten the landscape in mass plantings, as a specimen plant, or in a container.
- Butterfly Bush - Petite Indigo 5' X 5'
 Spectacular summer color of dark lavender to reddish-purple from slender flower spikes. Showy flowers attract butterflies. A useful dwarf form perfect as an accent plant or border.
- Dwarf Alberta Spruce 6' X 4'
 A perfect cone shaped dwarf conifer displaying dense green needles which are soft to the touch. Excellent as a container

Diablo Ninebark 8' X 8'
The deep purple foliage of this versatile shrub makes it a standout in the garden. A great dense hedge or screen. Profuse creamy-white flowers in summer. Foliage can become green in high heat or partial shade. Deciduous.

Rose of Sharon- Aphrodite 10' X 6'
Eye-catching shrub, valued for exceptional flowers and long bloom season. Heavily ruffled, clear pink blooms have a deep red eye. Little to no seed production means abundant, nearly continuous flowering. Densely branched habit with thick, deep green foliage is perfect for hedge or screen. Highly tolerant to air pollution and drought. Deciduous.

Rose of Sharon - Blushing Bride 10' X 6'
Outstanding flowering shrub that provides welcome color in summer. Large double flowers displayed on upright slender branches. Showy specimen, excellent hedge or screen. Deciduous.

Partial Sun

Rhododendron - Hagga 3' X 3'
Dense evergreen shrub is a highly valued landscape ornamental. Large trusses of showy pink flowers appear on even young plants. Prefers cooler regions. Very effective as an accent.

Hydrangea - Penny Mac 4' X 4'
This wildly popular selection requires minimal care, yet provides a prolific display of fantastic mophead flowers repeatedly throughout summer - perfect for the time-pressed gardener! Blooms tend to be blue in acid soils and pink in more alkaline soils. Mass for a dramatic effect or combine with perennials and shrubs in beds and borders. Deciduous.

Hydrangea - Annabelle 5' X 5'
This smooth Hydrangea cultivar features pure white flowers which are much larger than the species - up to 12 inches across! The strong, straight stems hold the blooms up well, even when saturated with water. Blooms in late spring to summer, often continuing into fall. This full, lush shrub needs plenty of room to show off its spectacular beauty. Deciduous.

Groundcover

Full sun

Phlox - Candy Stripe

Rugged, ground-hugging perennial creates a carpet of spring color! Masses of tiny white flowers with a pink mid stripe cover dense evergreen foliage, spreading easily on slopes, in rock gardens, along pathways or borders.

Phlox - Emerald Blue

Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of deep blue flowers top creeping stems and make an attractive groundcover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought when established. Evergreen.

Partial sun - full sun

Ajuga - Chocolate Chip

A dwarf, evergreen spreading groundcover that creates a tight mat of bronze-tinged, almost brown colored foliage. Beautiful in containers, around shrubs or between stepping stones.

Fire spinner Ice Plant

Stunning tri-colored flowers cover a tight, fast spreading mat of succulent evergreen foliage. The flowers are most prolific in spring, reappearing throughout the summer. Green-apple foliage keeps its shiny presence through winter. A Plant Select® winner, this hardy and heat-loving ground cover is perfect for use in waterwise landscapes.

Sedum - Bronze carpet

Beautiful trailing succulent perennial forms lush, ground hugging mats of brilliant bronze red, yet needs little water once established. Dainty pink flowers occasionally emerge from 6 to 9 inch stalks. Useful in borders, rock gardens or containers where it will provide excellent contrast to green or grey-leaved plants. Semi-evergreen in mild-winter areas.

Georgia Blue Speedwell

Masses of small blue flowers smother the glossy foliage for months and appear sporadically throughout the year. The evergreen foliage becomes bronzy-purple in winter. A great weed-suppressing groundcover or bulb cover.

Winter Glow Bergenia

Excellent evergreen perennial displays large glossy, dark green leaves in bold rosettes. Magenta flower clusters are lovely spring accents. Effective in shaded foreground plantings and borders.

Vines

Full sun

Trumpet - Balboa Sunset

20'

Large, tubular, dark red flowers in clusters create a dramatic show and attract hummingbirds all season long! Once established, thrives and blooms best with near neglect. This vigorous, clinging vine is ideal for quickly covering large areas as a groundcover, screening on lattice or cloaking an arbor. Deciduous.

Clematis - Starry Nights

6' - 10'

This stunning, compact selection captivates with majestic eight-inch brilliant purple to blue flowers streaked with a red to mauve bar. Center stamens are white flushed with red. Bloom color varies with light intensity and temperatures. Flowers shimmer as if dusted in gold as they age and fade. Expect a heavy flush in early spring to summer and a second flush in fall. Perfect for smaller garden spaces, where it can be enjoyed in a large container, climbing an arbor or wall.

Partial sun - full sun

Clematis - Pink champagne

6' - 8'

Smaller plant size makes this Clematis ideal for small gardens. Festive, deep-pink flowers can reach 6 to 8 inches in diameter. Petals are uniquely striped with white bars. Blossoms abundantly in early summer. Deciduous.

Clematis - Betty Corning

8' - 10'

This delicate and delightful vine produces a long procession of nodding lavender-blue flowers from mid-summer until early fall. New spring foliage is often tinted bronze, extending its seasonal interest. Its open growth habit makes for a lovely scene running through large shrubs or small trees. Flowers have a light, sweet fragrance.

Clematis - Jackman

10' - 12'

The most popular of the Clematis vines. Showy deep purple-violet flowers are slightly broader than those of C. 'Jackmanii' and will cover this climbing vine most of the summer. Excellent for trellises, fences, or on rock walls. Deciduous.

Part sun

Clematis - Nelly Moser

15'

Produces an amazing display of flowers; pink petals with dark pink bar in center, and reddish-brown stamens. Woody vine with leathery textured, dark green foliage. Deciduous

Perennial Plants

Full sun

Coreopsis - Pink Lemonade

10" X 12"

A great mixer in containers! Bright golden foliage gives a long season of interest until the bright, clear pink flowers arrive, attracting butterflies and bees. Forms a dainty, compact mound - perfect for low beds and mixed borders. May overwinter in mild winters; treat as an annual in colder zones.

Coreopsis - Ruby Frost

16" X 32"

An exciting color-breakthrough in Coreopsis breeding with large, deep ruby flowers fringed in frosty white. Blooms are displayed above compact foliage throughout summer, attracting butterflies in droves. Excellent for containers, edging walkways, cottage garden borders. Perennial.

Salvia - East Friesland

18" X 24"

A stunning addition to any border. Tall, 18 in. spikes of intense violet-blue flowers top gray-green foliage. Dense, shrub-like growth. Deciduous perennial.

Coneflower - Merlot

30" X 30"

Wine colored stems display rich pink flowers with huge golden orange cones. Blooms are fragrant and long lasting. Excellent for attracting butterflies and for naturalized gardens, traditional beds, borders or containers. Does not require staking. Hardy perennial.

Gaillardia - Commotion Frenzy

24" X 24"

Red buds open to fluted, dark red ray flowers with bright yellow tips. Red and yellow center. Great in perennial or butterfly gardens, borders and pots, or as cut flowers. Herbaceous perennial.

Gaillardia - Goblin

12" X 18"

A tough, heat-loving perennial with dazzling red and bright gold, butterfly-attracting blooms. Large flowers cover compact mounds for months on end. Use in borders, along paths or spot into rock gardens. Perfect addition to patio containers for summer color.

Gaura Passionate Rainbow

24" X 15"

Rose pink flowers appear in profusion along slender stems, spring to fall. Compact, easy-care perennial has attractive green leaves, neatly edged in white. Outstanding heat and drought tolerance. Spot into rock gardens, perennial borders or containers.

Daylily - Little Business

16" X 16"

A favored perennial admired for its abundant raspberry red flowers on tall stems. Blooms early to mid-season with repeat bloom. Clumps of grass-like foliage are deer resistant. An easy-care choice for border or container. Good for use in firescaping. Semi-evergreen in mild winter areas.

- Daylily - Grapette 16" X 16"
 Favorite flowering perennial. Large clumps of grass-like leaves are highlighted by lavender purple flowers on tall stems. This smaller growing selection reblooms throughout the summer months. Semi-evergreen in mild winter areas.
- Daylily - Strawberry Candy 18" X 36"
 A favorite perennial for its showy coral pink flowers with strawberry-red eye. Large clumps of long, grass-like leaves are highlighted by lily-like flowers on tall stems. An easy-care perennial that is good for firescaping. Herbaceous.
- Daylily - Red Rum 24" X 24"
 Vivid red flowers are a stand out in the summer garden. Flowers held well above grass-like bladed foliage. Prolific mid-season bloomer can be spotted into beds and borders for instant beauty. Good for firescaping. Semi-evergreen in mild winter climates.
- Daylily - Summer Wine 24" X 36"
 A favorite perennial for summer blooms. Large clumps of long, grass-like leaves are highlighted by lily-like flowers on tall stems. A diploid, mid season bloomer, this easy care perennial is perfect for massing in beds or borders. Good for use in firescaping. Herbaceous.
- Daylily - Pink Playmate 36" X 36"
 Bright pink 4 inch blooms appear early in the season on tall stems. Reblooms appear almost instantly after the previous set have finished. Plant this easy-care perennial in the rear of a perennial bed; excellent for firescaping.
- Iris - Butterflies in Flight 30" X 18"
 Sky blue flowers have dark blue veins contrast with rich violet-purple center petals. Blooms rise above the narrow green foliage on stiff stems - great for cut flowers. Excellent for perennial borders and water gardens. Herbaceous.
- Iris - Bennerup Blue Siberian 24" X 18"
 Beardless Dutch Iris-like blooms rise above refined, slender sword-like foliage. Use in mass plantings for the best effect. Thrives in moist soils, where others will not. Herbaceous perennial.
- Iris - Caesar's Brother 24" X 18"
 Beardless dark purple blooms rise above refined, slender sword-like foliage. Use in mass plantings for the best effect. Thrives in moist soils, where others will not. Herbaceous perennial.
- Rudbeckia - Goldstrum, Black Eyed Susan 24" X 18"
 Honored as the 1999 Perennial Plant of the Year! A showy border plant and excellent for cut flowers. Bright, daisy-like, golden yellow flowers with black centers. Heat and humidity tolerant.

Partial sun - full sun

- Dianthus - Firewitch 12" X 12"
Magenta-pink flowers bloom profusely, with a wonderful spicy clove-like fragrance. Bluish-gray, compact foliage quickly forms a solid mat, making it an excellent ground cover or rock garden plant. Essential to the cottage garden and perennial border. Evergreen perennial.
- Geranium - Ballerina 8" X 15"
Dainty, pink flowers marked with purple veining above lacy, gray green foliage. An outstanding, long blooming addition to borders or rock gardens. Herbaceous perennial.
- Geranium - Black Eyed Magenta 8" X 15"
Dainty, brilliant magenta flowers marked with black centers above lacy, dark green foliage. Red foliage in fall on this outstanding, long blooming addition to borders or rock gardens. Herbaceous perennial.
- Geranium - Rozanne 15" X 36"
Great small-scale groundcover for rock gardens! Dwarf spreading form with dainty violet flowers that show color for many months. Deep green foliage is lightly marbled chartreuse. Nearly evergreen in most climates. 2008 Perennial Plant of the Year.
- Daylily - Stella de oro 12" X 24"
Sensational, award-winning selection that blooms with heavy clusters of 2-1/2 in. yellow blooms. Reblooms freely into early fall. This easy to care for plant forms neat, compact clumps. Herbaceous.
- Heuchera - Midnight Bayou 18" X 18"
Great for edging and adding color and vivid contrast with green foliage plants. The brilliantly colored foliage creates spectacular background for the sprays of tiny white flowers. Well adapted to hot and humid Southern climates, with excellent resistance to powdery mildew. Evergreen.
- Heuchera - Midnight Rose 12" X 16"
Fabulous burnished black leaves are spotted hot pink in the spring, lightening in summer to cream and pink spots. Outstanding at close range for outdoor living areas and front entry foundation planting. Exceptional container plant for bold effects.
- Heuchera - Peach Flambé 12" X 14"
Expect multi-season interest with glowing bright peach-colored leaves infused with flaming red from spring to fall, turning to plum-purple as the weather cools. A superb companion with seasonal garden color. Provides bold texture and color contrast in mixed containers or borders in bright or dappled shade. Evergreen in mild winter climates.
- Heuchera - Pistache 14" X 14"
Striking lime-green foliage backs creamy flowers on long, sturdy stems over an especially long bloom period. Striking when massed in a woodland border or tucked into a rock garden. Tolerant of heat and humidity. Evergreen.

Heuchera - Rose Majesty 8" X 16"

Astilbe - Hennie 12" X 18"
A dwarf Astilbe with plumes of unique star shaped, rose-pink colored flowers that last for many weeks. Plant in masses or as edging in perennial borders. Good for informal woodlands and shaded landscapes under trees.

- Astilbe - Red Sentinel 24" X 24"
Scarlet red blooms are a popular cut flower for shade gardens. At home in the woodland garden or under shade trees that love moisture. Herbaceous perennial.
- Bleeding Heart 16" X 16"
